

**THE LAW ON AMENDMENTS AND ADDENDA TO THE
LAW ON CUSTOMS POLICY OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA**

**The Law
on Amendments and Addenda to the
Law on Customs Policy of Bosnia and Herzegovina**

Article 1

In the Law on Customs Policy of Bosnia and Herzegovina (*BiH Official Gazette*, nr. 57/04), in the Article 176, Paragraph 3, the full-stop following the item (b) shall be deleted and the conjunction “and” shall be added, followed by a new item (c) that shall read:

“(c) financed in majority part by foreign donors or international development banks and in minority part out of the budget.”

In the same Article, following the Paragraph 3, a new Paragraph 4 is added, which should read:

“4. Equipment that is put in use and is intended for the conduct of the production activity in the free zones is exempt from customs duty.”

Previous Paragraph 4 will become Paragraph 5.

In the previous Paragraph 5, which shall become Paragraph 6, the number “4” shall be replaced by the number “5.”

This Law shall enter into force on the 8th day as of the date of publishing in the “BiH Official Gazette.”
